Course Overview

Our Build Your Career program is designed and delivered specifically for those job seekers wanting to gain entry level skills and knowledge to start a career in the Building and Construction industry.

In partnership with Housing SA, our program prepares job seekers for real employment opportunities with builders and contractors working with Housing SA. Our on-the-job training model provides job seekers with hands on experience and application to skills and knowledge learned and our Learner Support Services staff are available onsite to assist with any challenges affecting your learning journey.

Course Content

This course combines structured workplace training on an actual live construction site, practical work sessions and theory-based learning. Our students develop skills and knowledge including:

- General use of construction tools and equipment
- Work Health and Safety requirements for working in the Building and Construction industry
- Undertaking construction projects and works
- Interpreting construction plans and specifications

Career Pathways

On successful completion of assessment requirements, the learner will be issued with a Full Certificate, **FSK20119 Certificate II in Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways**.

Delivery

- 12-week program delivered 2 days per week (Mon & Fri)
- All training occurs on the worksite, locations vary and will be discussed upon enrolment

Cost

Fee free for eligible participants.

Pre-requisites

Learners must have already obtained and be able to provide a Statement of Attainment: **CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (White Card)**. This can be obtained through SYC Learning prior to course commencement.

Entry Level Requirements

- Learners must demonstrate the ability to understand and use basic Language, Literacy and Numeracy.
- Students will need to provide their own Steel capped boots and PPE prior to the commencement of course commencement.
- All learners must provide their USI upon enrolment.
- Learners must have obtained and be able to provide a Statement of Attainment: **CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (White Card)**. This can be obtained through SYC Learning prior to course commencement.
- Job Seekers referred by a Jobactive Provider will require an “**Employment Service Provider Referral to Training**” form.
- All participants of the course must provide 100 points of identification with at least 1 form of photo identification.
