Housing SA's Building and Construction Course

What is the program?

Housing SA, in partnership with not-for-profit training provider SYC (RTO 40053), is offering a building and construction course in 2020.

The course runs full-time for 10 weeks and aims to provide skills and training to prepare participants for job opportunities with builders and contractors used by Housing SA.

Successful graduates of the course will achieve:

- ✓ (FSK20113) Certificate II in Skills for Work and Vocational Pathways incorporating accredited units from (CPC20112) Certificate II in Construction Inc.
- ✓ (CPCCCM1012A) Work effectively and sustainably in the construction industry
- ✓ (CPCCCM2010B) Work safely at heights

Are you?

A job seeker who is:

- ✓ a Housing SA tenant/resident
- ✓ a community housing tenant
- ✓ on a waiting list register for a Housing SA property
- ✓ receiving Housing SA Private Rental Assistance
- ✓ at risk of requiring social housing.

You will also need:

- motivation and commitment to gain work in the building and construction industry
- to be able to pass a pre-employment medical, including drug and alcohol testing - random drug and alcohol testing within program
- to be physically fit
- a White Card is required to be able to work at a live construction site*.

How to apply

You will need to attend an information and assessment session, which will provide details about the program and an opportunity to meet some of the builders offering employment.

The Certificate II is subsidised through the Government of South Australia's, Department for Innovation and Skills.

A co-contribution of \$195 is required for a PPE pack and drug and alcohol testing. This should be covered by your jobactive or DES provider.
