Course Overview

This qualification provides an introduction to the construction industry, its culture, occupations, job roles and workplace expectations. Skills achieved will assist students in undertaking a Certificate II or entering an Australian Apprenticeship in the building and construction industry.

Program details

Building Links is designed to give students hands-on experience by renovating and remodelling existing Housing SA properties.

This course combines structured workplace training at a live construction site, practical work sessions and theory.

Delivery

This course is delivered one day per week 8:30am to 3pm for the full school year. Commences Week 1, Term 1 2021.

High visibility tops and basic personal protective equipment is provided. Students will need their own steel capped work boots and other appropriate clothing.

Day to be confirmed on expression of interest.

Location

White Card training occurs at the Youth Education Centre. Practical work commences after completion of the White Card at a live construction site provided by Housing SA. Location of construction site to be confirmed prior to training start date.

Skills

You will learn about the processes, materials, tools and equipment used and develop specialised skills and knowledge associated with construction industry.

Cost

Full fee

\$2,705 including GST. This also includes the fee for White Card training.
