Course Overview

This qualification provides an introduction to the construction industry.

Skills achieved will assist students in undertaking a Certificate III or entering an Australian Apprenticeship in the building and construction industry.

Program details

Building Links is designed to give students hands-on experience by renovating and remodelling existing Housing SA properties.

This course combines structured workplace training at a live construction site, practical work sessions and theory.

You will learn about the processes, materials, tools and equipment used and develop specialised skills and knowledge associated with construction industry.

Delivery

This course is delivered one day per week from 8:30am to 3pm for the full school year. Commences Week 1, Term 1 2021. High visibility tops and basic personal protective equipment is provided. Students will need their own steel capped work boots and other appropriate clothing.
