Course Overview

We work in collaboration with Registered Training Organisations to support students with their identified bridging units.

We communicate regularly with you on your students progression in their required bridging unit ensuring your compliance requirements are met.

Upfront Assessment of Need (UAN)

All individuals who are seeking access to a subsidised training place, regardless of prior educational attainment, are required to complete an Upfront Assessment of Need. Students are often identified as needing to complete bridging units before commencing their course.

We have been working alongside Government in supporting RTOs who do not have Foundation Skills on scope since 2018. We provide a comprehensive Foundation Skills training package to support students to attain their desired qualification.

Skills

We provide the following services:

- Mentoring students through the UAN Process
- Interpretation reports
- Delivery of Foundation Skills Bridging Units
- Learner Support Services to help student address other non-vocational barriers to study

Conditions of Access to Subsidised Training

Compliance with undertaking identified bridging units is monitored by the Department and non-compliance may result in the withdrawal of subsidy for a training account.

Cost

Funded by the Government of South Australia.* All learning materials provided at no extra cost.

Delivery

These units can be delivered face to face either one-on-one or in a small group setting at various SYC sites across metropolitan Adelaide. Online options are available with Zoom support for students. Please speak to our friendly team about the best delivery mode for your students.

Foundation Skills Bridging Units can be undertaken before or during the student's vocational qualification.

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Units

On completion of the Core Skills for Adults (CSPA) Interpretation Report up to five foundation skills bridging units are identified. An example of these units can be:

FSKDIG003	Use digital technology for non-routine workplace tasks
FSKLRG010	Use routine strategies for career planning
FSKNUM015	Estimate, measure and calculate with routine metric measurements for work
FSKNUM014	Calculate with whole numbers and familiar fractions, decimals and percentages for work
FSKWGTG009	Write routine workplace texts

We have a Foundation Skills training package on our ASQA scope and a Funded Activities Agreement in place with the Department for Innovation and Skills.

Eligibility
