SSDISO1008 - Introduction to Construction Skill Set



Course Overview

Our Build Your Career program is a state-based skill set, designed and delivered specifically for those job seekers wanting to gain entry level skills and knowledge to start a career in the Building and Construction industry.

In partnership with South Australian Housing Authority (SAHA), our program prepares job seekers for real employment opportunities with builders and contractors working with Housing SA. Our on-the-job training model provides job seekers with hands on experience and application to skills and knowledge learned and our Learner Support Services staff are available onsite to assist with any challenges affecting your learning journey.

Course Content

This course combines accredited workplace training on a live construction site, practical work sessions and theory-based learning. Our students develop skills and knowledge including:

- Construction induction training (White Card)
- Working safely at heights
- General use of construction tools and equipment
- Work Health and Safety requirements for working in the Building and Construction industry
- Undertaking construction projects and works
- Interpreting construction plans and specifications

Pathways

Entry Requirements/Pre-requisites

- All participants of the course must provide 100 points of identification with at least 1 form of photo identification
