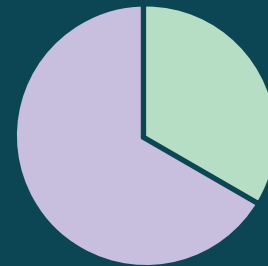

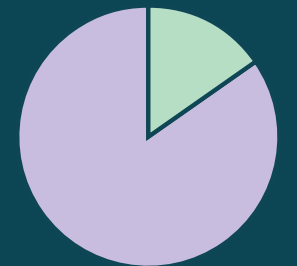
Of the people we supported...
